Imagine yourself finding an old car in a barn—Well here at the Gilmore Car Museum that is a daily reality. Nestled on 90 landscaped acres in restored historic barns are over 200 extraordinary vehicles spanning more than 100 years of automotive heritage. At the Gilmore Car Museum, considered one of the *TOP FIVE* car museums in the nation, you'll discover exhibits ranging from a 1899 Locomobile, to the classic Duesenberg or the elusive Tucker '48, and from the Model T to the muscle cars of the 60s and 70s.

We recommend that you allow at least 2.5 - 3 hours to get the most out of your visit, and wear comfortable shoes. You'll also want to allow extra time to visit the Miniature's Museum and have a snack or lunch in our authentic **1941 Blue Moon Diner**. All buildings are wheelchair accessible with two upper levels accessed by large ramps (one shown in the photo above).

The Gilmore Car Museum, located midway between Kalamazoo, Grand Rapids, and Battle Creek, Michigan is just twenty minutes from I-94 and US-131.

Whether you only have an hour to spend or the better part of a day you will certainly enjoy a remarkable experience.
